Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration, and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, lays non-metallic pipe including concrete, sewer, drainage, transite, and underground tile pipe in ditches and trenches; makes up joints; grades pipe to insure proper drainage; makes hydrostatic tests of non-metallic pipe; loads and unloads materials and equipment; and performs related duties.

1. Overtime:

Employees shall be compensated for each hour of overtime worked on Sundays and holidays (or holiday equivalents), at a rate computed by multiplying the appropriate hourly rate by two (2); for each hour of all other such overtime at a rate computed by multiplying the appropriate hourly rate by one and one-half (1½).

2. Holidays: (Eff. 7/1/93)

Holidays shall be as follows: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, the day after Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. If any of the above holidays falls on Sunday, the Monday following shall be considered the holiday.

4. Show-up:

An employee who reports for work at the regular starting time and for whom no work is provided shall receive pay for two (2) hours at the stipulated rate for so reporting unless he has been notified before the end of his last preceding shift not to report.
