### Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration, and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, directs a crew of painters engaged in painting structural steel and other metal surfaces, including plates and brackets, anchors, floor plates, and monorail beams; examines and interprets instructions, orders, plans and specifications and observes and analyzes site of proposed work; plans, lays out and coordinates proposed work with other crafts; determines methods and tools to be employed; supervises mixing of paints and other protective coatings, and preparation of surfaces for painting; examines and reviews tasks and assumes responsibility for quality and quantity of work during progress and after completion; encourages safe practices and enforces safety rules and precautions; approves workmen's timecards; makes oral and written reports on such matters as work progress, materials used and attendance; hears and settles grievances or refers to his superior; and performs related duties.

#### 1. Overtime

For each hour or portion thereof worked beyond the normal work shift including Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, an employee shall be compensated at one and one-half (1½) times the straight-time rate. (Eff. 7/1/85.)
