### Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration, and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, performs plumbing following plans, specifications, and written and oral instructions; installs sewers, air lines, oil lines, low pressure steam lines, water, gas and chemical lines, sprinkler systems both fire and lawn, refrigerating and heating, cooling, and drainage systems and water softeners; cuts, threads and installs piping caulks, wipes and tests lead joints; uses chain tongs, acetylene cutting outfits, and flaring tools for cutting and fitting pipes and plumbing fixtures; performs rigging incidental to plumbing work; directs the work of assigned helpers; drives motor vehicles; and performs related duties.

- 1a. Overtime: For all time worked in excess of ten (10) hours per day Monday through Saturday and all time worked on Sundays and holidays, an employee shall be compensated at a rate computed by multiplying the hourly rate by two (2). All other overtime shall be compensated at the time and one-half (1½) rate. (Eff. 7/1/88)

When an employee is called back subsequent to his normal shift, he shall be paid a minimum of two (2) hours pay at a rate computed by multiplying the hourly rate by two (2).
