Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration, and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, matches and fits fabricated structural steel members and shapes as columns, plates, girders, roof trusses, metal stairways, and fire escapes; erects and unites them primarily to form a structure or structural framework; fastens contiguous parts by bolting or riveting, or bolts them in place for welding; uses acetylene and electric welding equipment to perform incidental welding not requiring certification and to do burning and cutting of structural steel members; occasionally performs minor drilling, reaming, and cutting for proper fit; performs skilled rigging in moving and placing heavy materials and equipment, using ropes, cables, blocks and slings; sets up gin poles, derricks and other hoisting and rigging equipment for use in raising and placing structural steel, signals for hoisting and placing members by means of arm and hand motions; directs assigned helpers and performs related duties.

1. Overtime:

An employee shall be compensated, at a rate computed by multiplying the hourly rate by one and one-half (1½), for the following time worked: the first two (2) hours worked in excess of eight (8) hours per day, Monday through Friday; and the first eight (8) hours worked on Saturday.
