Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, directs and, when supervising less than seven men, frequently participates in the work of a crew of journeyman plumbers and their helpers engaged in installing, repairing and replacing pipe, valves, plumbing fixtures, sanitary plumbing, sewers, gas, oil and water lines, and welding, brazing and rigging incidental to plumbing activities; examines and interprets instructions, orders, plans and specifications, and observes and analyzes site of proposed work; prepares rough sketches and lays out all work not covered by specific blueprints; plans, lays out and coordinates proposed work with other crafts; determines methods and tools to be employed, assigns and reviews tasks and assumes responsibility for quality and quantity of work during progress and after completion; inspects all work for conformity to applicable building permits; encourages safe practices and enforces safety rules and precautions; approves workmen's timecards; makes oral and written reports on such matters as work progress, materials used and accidents; drives motor vehicles; and performs related duties.

- 1a. Overtime: For all time worked in excess of ten (10) hours per day Monday through Saturday and all time worked on Sundays and holidays, an employee shall be compensated at a rate computed by multiplying the hourly rate by two (2). All other overtime shall be compensated at the time and one-half (1½) rate. (Eff. 7/1/88.)

When an employee is called back subsequent to his normal shift, he shall be paid a minimum of two (2) hours pay at a rate computed by multiplying the hourly rate by two (2).
