Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration, and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, and in accordance with blueprint plans and specification, rough sketches, on-the-job measurements, and oral and written instructions, measures, cuts, reams, bends, threads, and installs various sizes of pipes and tubing made of steel, wrought iron, cast iron, copper, brass, hard rubber, and other materials, and also valves, fittings and similar accessories, for conveying steam at high and low pressures and temperatures, hot and cold water, air, gas, oil, and other fluids and gases; lays out piping, measures for and cuts to close tolerance for length and angle, and assembles pipe to close fits by use of threaded, caulked bell, wiped lead, bolted, flanged, welded and other joints; occasionally sets, aligns as to location, and connects factory-assembled units such as motor-driven pumps and water coolers; installs and replaces steam traps and other fittings that are integral parts of pipe lines; grinds and packs valves, packs pumps; replaces defective flanges and gaskets during testing and preliminary operating periods; flares tubing, installs fittings, and solders patented joints, fashions and installs pipe hangers; occasionally performs rigging incidental to industrial pipefitting; directs one or more helpers performing semi-skilled phases of job, and
