Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration, and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, operates and tends air compressors to supply compressed air for operation of pneumatic tools and equipment; opens and closes valves that control supply of air to tools and equipment, regulates automatic constant pressure controls to maintain required pressure; interprets readings of temperatures and pressure gauges and makes adjustments to equipment; operates portable and stationary pumps for dewatering excavations and for other construction purposes; maintains discharge rate within predesignated limits; lubricates, maintains and makes minor running adjustments and repairs to pump and compressor units, including motors; occasionally operates and makes running repairs to pneumatic tools and equipment; and performs related duties.

1. Overtime

Employees shall be compensated for each hour worked on holidays (or holiday equivalents), at a rate computed by multiplying the appropriate hourly rate by three (3); for each hour worked on Sundays, and in excess of four (4) hours overtime on a normal workday, and in excess of twelve (12) hours on a Saturday, at a rate computed by multiplying the appropriate hourly rate by two (2); and for each hour of all other overtime at a rate computed by multiplying the appropriate hourly rate by one and one-half (1½), except that when an employee is working overtime with other trades or
